A SAFE RETURN TO SCHOOL

Spring has arrived and we are all looking forward to warm sunny days, and lots of fun times outdoors. We have plenty of activities waiting for your children as they return in term 4, with the release of new Homework Club Literacy and Numeracy booklets. We also cannot wait to release our new Homework Heroes; a series of collectible cards that children can collect and swap.

As the state is about to hit a 70% fully vaccination rate, the government announced last week that children are set to return to their classrooms one week earlier than planned. Thank you to the families who have advised us of the date of their children's return to Inspire. If we have not heard back from you, we will continue to suspend your account until further notice.

For children returning to Inspire this week, we remind families of our CovidSafe procedures, including:

- washing of hands and/or use of hand sanitisers regularly
- checking in on our QR code (even when you are not entering the centre)
- continue to collect your children from the foyer/entry to the centre
- get tested even if you or your children have the mildest of Covid-19 symptoms

If your child displays flu-like symptoms, we will request a negative Covid-19 result before they can return to Inspire.

All school and childcare staff are required to be fully vaccinated by 8th November 2021. The Department of Education has advised that only fully vaccinated staff can continue to work from this date onwards unless of course, they have a medical exemption. Our head office team is busy collating our staff's vaccination status to ensure that we can comply by this date.
